There are large vases among those in my original 'Reed Painter' list, but they do not bridge the gap between the small and Group R: the quality is no better than in the small.

THE TRIGLYPH PAINTER

Buschor ALP. 19-20. ARV. 1828-30.

Named by Buschor, from the groups of three vertical lines that sometimes adorn the stele. Often large. Overblown style.
